## Board Meeting March 12, 2024

## Flag Salute

**Adopt Agenda:** Supervisor Mona Mathews made a motion to adopt agenda. Supervisor Paul Travis seconded. All voted yes, motion carried.

# Approve Minutes: February 13th meeting minutes:

A. Supervisor Mona Mathews made a motion to approve February 13, 2024 Town Board meeting minutes. Chair Jennifer Meyer seconded the motion. All voted yes, motion carried.

#### Visit Eau Claire:

A. Dana Crosson from Visit Eau Claire was in attendance to distribute report. Dana mentioned to Board that she will try to send report electronically next Month. Benny Anderson has resigned from Visit Eau Claire.

## Comp Plan:

A. Conditional Use Permit (CUP); McIntyre, 6178 W. Cameron St. 1.963 acres, addition of a 14 x30 pole building; Zoning Code RH; EC CTY Title 18 18.41.010 Accessory Uses & Structures: Comp Plan met and found no Issues with this CUP.

Chair Jennifer Meyer made a motion to approve the CUP.

Supervisor Mona Mathews seconded the motion. All voted yes, motion carried.

#### **Park Commission:**

- A. March 6, 2024, meeting update: Chair Jennifer Meyer gave an update on March 6<sup>th</sup> meeting. Beaver Creek would like to have some events at Conservancy. Chair Jennifer Meyer brought up putting a sign up regarding burning in the fire pit. Supervisor Mona Mathews mentioned putting a QR code out at Conservancy for people to scan and read burning restrictions and if it is safe to burn.
- B. Pavilion at Conservancy: Supervisor Jeff Whyte did receive a quote from Buesser Concrete for the Pavilion, quote was for \$6,710.00.

#### Fire Station #3:

A. Battalion Chief Eddy Yates was not in attendance. Supervisor Paul Travis and Supervisor Megan Bischel gave an update. They did have a Shed fire in Pleasant Valley. Also had, Wild Land Training, this was a grass fire and it went towards a house. It is dry outside right now, so fire danger is high. Family Fun night at the Fire station, will be this Sunday, March 17th at 5pm. Awards Banquet will be April 5<sup>th</sup> at the Moose Lodge. HSHS Sacred Heart Hospital will be closing March 22<sup>nd</sup>. EMS, Firefighters, and police will be there for the closing.

#### Roads:

- A. County Line Rd./Dennis Mack Cedar Corp: Dennis Mack from Cedar Corp was in attendance and mentioned that they did meet with Haas and Menards. They are still waiting to hear back from them if they will help with project. Need to get moving on this project. First have to decide if Town needs to purchase land and then get the project out for bids.
- B. Weight limit restrictions lifted Monday, March 4, 2024.
- C. "Method of deployment" to Wis DOT Bureau of Structures for the Town Small Bridge/Culvert Inventory due April 15, 2024: Town will have to inventory culverts and bridges. Town can either hire it done or have the County do the work and then have to replace any with issues. First step is to get them all inventoried. Town will be reimbursed \$100 to locate and inventory each culvert/bridge and \$350 to inspect. Dennis Mack from Cedar Corp mentioned to the Board that he has already worked on this for another town.
  - Supervisor Mona Mathews made a motion to hire Cedar Corp. for the Small Town Bridge/Culvert deployment, to inventory all culverts.
  - Supervisor Megan Bischel seconded the motion. All voted yes, motion carried.
- D. Road Maintenance: Town needs to look at which roads will need work this year. ATV route within Eau Claire County, still working on which roads and mapping.
