Parks Discussion

Sherman Creek Park

Dean and Fred updated the Commission on the progress with the Aylen Bain Memorial. They continue to have communication with the group that is in charge of the memorial project. The price quoted by Super Sign Man is \$ 100 per sign. Barb will be joining Dean and Fred on the sub-committee.

Chippewa Valley Tree Care, LLC completed tree maintenance and invoice will be sent. Matt Staudenmaier stated most evident issues were taken care of and work was completed in 6.5 hours. He suggested clearing buckthorn along the trails this fall. Barb will reach out to Chippewa Valley Biodiversity to see if they are interested in the project.

Conservancy

Someone dumped a tire at the fire pit. After camera footage was reviewed the information was given to the Eau Claire County Sheriff's Department. They made contact with the person who dumped the tire.

Someone dumped a large quantity of pallets at the fire pit. Again the camera footage was reviewed. The individual was given a week to clean them up. They are cleaned up.

The Commission has contacted Blue Ox to do trail maintenance again this fall. It will be done prior to the fall event.

The Fall Event is scheduled for Saturday, October 19. Fred has the horse drawn wagon rides scheduled. Landmark will set up a table but will not do a hike. The food will be the same as last year; hot dogs, chips, cookies and water. Jennifer will contact the fire department to see if a drone demonstration is possible.

Eau Claire Outdoors held their fire building demonstration July 21, camera footage showed 10 people met in the pavilion. Their next event is a poetry hike on September 28.

Old Business

The Visit Eau Claire Survey will be completed August 23. The data will be analyzed in September and a report generated in October.

Tony reported on the Rural Partners Network – Outdoor Recreation Workgroup. A \$ 70,000 grant will be used to promote recreation activities in the eight county areas (website and branding). The end goal is to bring people to the area to spend money while in town.

New Business

The DNR Urban Forestry Grant was discussed. The option of conducting a survey at the Fall Event to determine future improvements to the Town of Union Parks was discussed.
